Notes on Additional Information Required for Concessionary Membership.

Criterion	Type	Information Required
2	Academic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If applying as an institution, please supply a list of all eligible full-time academic staff including their BCA membership numbers. If applying as an individual, please provide evidence that you are a full-time member of an eligible institution e.g. payslip or a letter from the institution concerned. Successful applicants will be charged at the BCA concessionary rate.
3	Maternity/ Paternity/Shared Parenting/ Adoption	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members should inform us in writing when they are about to go on maternity/paternity/shared parental/adoption leave, at which point their insurance will be nullified except for 'keeping in touch' days when they will continue to be covered. No BCA membership fees will be charged. Members should inform us in writing of the date of return to work, at which point their normal insurance cover will be restored. They will then receive the Concessionary Rate of BCA membership for the balance of the calendar year of return. Applications can be made at any time of the year once leave dates have been firmed up. The minimum period of leave is 16 weeks for either parent.
4	Low Income	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members who apply under this criterion should submit documentary evidence that their income is below the per annum gross £16,000 threshold. This may be in the form of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Audited accounts which show that their share of a business, turns over less than the threshold. P60. P45. Tax Return self employment pages, tax computation and HMRC tax overview. Any other documentation to confirm that turnover is below £16,000.
5	Exceptional Circumstances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members who apply under this criterion should explain their circumstances in detail in writing e.g. family tragedy, serious illness. All decisions reached by the Board under this criterion will be on a case-by-case basis.
